What is post-bariatric surgery body contouring?

Many post-bariatric surgery patients have significant areas of excess skin, including areas on the face, abdomen, arms, breasts and thighs. Post-bariatric surgery body contouring encompasses a range of procedures that eliminate the excess skin and help to enhance a patient's appearance following significant weight loss.

Who will do the surgery?

At the Ambulatory Surgery Center, body contouring is done by a board-certified plastic surgeon who understands the unique needs of post-bariatric surgery patients and who has experience in body contouring techniques. Rather than focusing on one type of procedure, such as a tummy tuck, the plastic surgeon's approach is to consider the patient's needs from head to toe and work collaboratively with the patient to achieve the desired results. In addition, a dedicated and highly skilled staff of board-certified anesthesiologists, certified nurse anesthetists, registered nurses and certified surgical technicians ensure the best possible care for all patients.



Will insurance cover these procedures?

Most health insurance policies do not cover these types of procedures. The cost varies depending on the type of procedure and your individual needs. Your initial consultation with the plastic surgeon will include information about costs and payment plans.
