Fact Sheet

New Ulm Medical Center Surgery Center Expansion & Renovation Project

Annually, New Ulm Medical Center performs more than 1,800 surgical procedures. The goal of the Surgery Center Expansion project was to reconstruct and expand the outdated existing Surgery Center for increased privacy and capacity for patients, as well as provide more comfortable and attractive space for families and staff.

What's New

- Two 575-sq. ft. operating rooms (ORs)
- Renovation of one existing operating room
- Ceiling lift for enhanced staff and patient safety
- Renovation of post anesthesia recovery area for greater patient privacy
- Renovation of 10 pre-operative and recovery rooms that provide increased privacy for surgery patients
- Family waiting area that is welcoming and conveniently located
- Staff and physician support space
- Family consultation room for increased privacy

Total Project Costs

- Construction: \$3 million
- Equipment & Furnishings: \$500,000

Types of Surgical Procedures

- General surgery, such as appendectomies, breast biopsies and gall bladder removal
- OB/GYN, such as hysterectomies and C-sections
- Orthopedics, such as total knee and hip replacements
- Ear, nose and throat, such as tonsillectomies
- Ophthalmology, such as cataract repairs

Project Funding

Allina Hospitals & Clinics committed \$2.75 million to the Surgery Center Expansion & Renovation project in early 2007. In partnership with the community and the New Ulm Medical Center Foundation (NUMC), an additional \$760,000 was raised through philanthropic contributions.

The NUMC Foundation extends a special thank you to nearly 2,000 donors who supported the Surgery Center Expansion & Renovation Project Capital Campaign with a philanthropic gift.

A Donor Celebration Recognition Wall is located in the Surgery Center Reception area recognizing our major donors to the project.
