

Emergency Department Construction Project

- WHAT:** Brand new \$11.5 million Emergency Department, front entrance, outpatient registration area and imaging services (CT/MRI/x-ray) space.
- WHERE:** Regina Hospital, 1175 Nininger Road, Hastings, MN 55033
- WHY:** When Regina Hospital joined Allina Health, Allina Health pledged to develop a new Emergency Department – a longtime goal of the hospital – to better serve the needs of the community.
- KEY DATES:** **January 1, 2014** – Regina Hospital became part of Allina Health
August, 2014 – Hammel, Green and Abrahamson, Inc, was selected as the project architect; Kraus-Anderson selected as the project contractor
September, 2014 – Architectural planning began
October, 2014 – Plans submitted to Hastings City Council for approval
November 24, 2014 – Planning Commission at Hastings City Council reviewed submitted plans and recommended approval
December 1, 2014 – The full Hastings City Council approved the application
December 18, 2014 – Groundbreaking ceremony to mark the start of construction
- KEY STATS:** **12,000 sq ft** – size of the new Emergency Department (previously 7,000 sq ft)
18,700 sq ft – size of entire construction project (new and renovated space)
\$11.5 million – cost of entire construction project
10 patient bays (comprising 8 treatment rooms and 2 trauma bays)
11,000 visits annually to Regina Hospital Emergency Department
20-25 construction workers on average expected on site for the project (could range from 5-40+ depending on the stage of the project)
