Transcatheter Aortic Valve Replacement (TAVR)

A procedure that uses a catheter device to place a new aortic valve in your heart

- The TAVR procedure is performed collaboratively with an Interventional Cardiologist and a Cardiac Surgeon.
- The TAVR Coordinators will help coordinate all the testing and work-up required for the placement of your new heart valve. They will be updating you and your family regularly on the plan of care and will be a consistent resource for answering your questions.
- The advanced practitioner will be assisting in your care during your hospital stay. Typically, you will meet with our Physician Assistant approximately one week after your hospital discharge for a follow-up visit.
