# Dynamic St. Paul family makes a difference at United for generations

## Meet John Kuhrmeyer and Janet Kuhrmeyer

“True satisfaction in life comes from serving others,” said John C. Kuhrmeyer, CFP, ChFc, CLU, Canopy Financial Group. In fact, this seems to be something he was raised to do. “Both of my parents are very involved in philanthropy. They have a heart for those things that help people.”

The Kuhrmeyer family history with United started decades ago. During the 1950s, all three of Carl and Janet Kuhrmeyer’s children were born at St. Luke’s Hospital. More than 20 years later, St. Luke’s would merge with Miller Hospital to become United Hospitals, Incorporated. In 1985, this name would change to what is now known as United Hospital.

The Kuhrmeyer family is still part of the United family. Since 2001, Janet, a former nurse and active community volunteer, volunteers in the newborn nursery at United Hospital. She spends her time rocking babies, changing diapers and bringing babies to moms. “I’ve noticed a change over the last few years,” she said. “I have to bring the babies to the mother’s room much less now. Babies tend to stay in the room with mom.”

In June, 2016, Janet will celebrate her 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary at United. During this time, she has given more than 2,799 service hours. “Janet doesn’t let much stop her from her Monday morning commitment, not snow or rain. She is a regular fixture on her service day. She is just a delight,” said Debbie Walczak, supervisor, Volunteer Services.

The nursing staff she works with agrees. “Janet is a joy to have in the newborn nursery as a volunteer. She shows true commitment and devotion. She shows up with a big smile every morning ready to work! She is always in good spirits. She has a great rapport with doctors and staff.”

Carl and Janet have three children: Karen, John and Paul, plus seven grandsons. “I’m so proud of all my children,” Janet said. Karen is now part of the Children’s Hospital Association board, a role that Mrs. Kuhrmeyer also held until just recently. With two master’s degrees in hand, Paul is working on his doctorate in business. Their son, John, is ramping up involvement with the United Hospital Foundation.

“John,” said Janet, “was always a fun loving kid. He is very thoughtful and caring. He still maintains childhood friendships to this day. He has a gift for creating and maintaining relationships.”

For more than 20 years, John has been Chairman of the Board with Phoenix Alternatives, Inc. (PAI, Inc.). This small nonprofit provides day training services for young adults, adults and seniors with disabilities. The group recently started a new bus company, Newtrax, for the sole purpose of providing transportation to PAI’s clients and others with similar needs.

Known for building and maintaining long-term relationships, John first became involved with PAI in the early 90s when he met with a founding leader to create a retirement plan. Recognizing a shared interest in serving people, John became part of the board of directors soon after.

When not helping people achieve their financial goals, building client and business relationships and friendships, he can be found volunteering at his church. He, and wife, Diane, give generously of their time and talents to the Woodbury community through their church. John and Diane have been married almost 34 years and have two grown sons, AJ and Daniel, who live in different states. They travel frequently to see them, and have a family Heli ski trip planned.

# Area business leader experiences sudden cardiac arrest

**“Ambulance arriving, Trauma 1, SCA Code Blue”** is how I imagined my arrival at the Peter J. King Emergency Care Center. Much of what happened for and to me during my stay at United Hospital has been shared with me by family and friends. You will understand why after I tell you my story.

Saturday morning, Feb. 7, 2015, I was sitting in a barber’s chair after getting my haircut. My stylist, who is my wife’s cousin, thought I had fallen asleep as my head sagged forward. Another patron realized that I was having a serious medical issue, got me out of the chair and onto the floor. I was very fortunate there were three women with extensive first responder experience, waiting for rides after their appointments. The women took turns performing CPR until the paramedic teams arrived. I later learned I had a ventricular fibrillation that led to a full cardiac arrest.

The paramedics continued CPR while they prepared to use a LUCAS device (a portable device that administers CPR in a very effective, albeit violent, manner.) Interesting note: Many of the LUCAS devices used by local fire departments and ambulance crews were provided through the United Hospital Foundation. The paramedics also used an AED three times to shock my heart. I was transported with the LUCAS device pumping away and an IV in my shin. My stylist had called my wife during this time to let her know I needed to go to a hospital.

The Emergency Department (ED) at United Hospital is state-of-the-art and operates like a well-oiled machine. The first minutes and hours are the most critical when diagnosing and treating cardiac conditions. I was being treated by the best and the

brightest, even though I didn’t know it at the time. Knowing the Nasseff Heart Center was next door comforted my family.

While I was being treated and stabilized, my family was taken to a lounge to await news. You can imagine what they were going through, dealing with the shock of my sudden and unexpected heart failure. The charge nurse, attending physician, cardiologist and interns took turns visiting them with updates and answering questions. I will always be grateful for the compassion they showed my family during this trying time.

My care team followed all of the best practices in treating me. My body temperature was lowered to 90 degrees for 36 hours. I required almost constant monitoring during this time. Part of their job was taking off the blankets that my wife put on me because I was shivering. Sunday night they removed the cooling device and allowed my temperature to rise. My body did not react well and they deepened my coma. My family was told this would be the turning point in my recovery, for better or worse. What we didn’t understand at the time was that I might never return to my former self.

I was in a medically induced coma for three more days in keeping with best practices for patients with possible anoxic brain damage. It took several days to completely come out of the coma. I slowly became

aware of my surroundings and interacted with staff and family. There were many tests performed during the first week of my stay at United. I also worked with staff from Courage Kenny Rehabilitation Institute™ to assess my physical and cognitive status. Nobody knew for sure how long I had been deprived of oxygen or what type of long-term therapy I needed.

Then, the magic happened. One day, I did not know my age or date of birth. Three days later, I was back to solving math problems in my head that most people would need a calculator to solve. I began moving around my room, and eventually the rest of the floor using a walker. In a matter of days, I was walking without any assistance. However, it did take me a while to figure out how to disable the alarm they had attached to me in an attempt to keep me in bed! I ordered everything I could from the food menu, and waited anxiously each day for the newspaper to work the New York Times crossword puzzle. The staff at the hair salon nicknamed me M&M, for Miracle Man. Dr. Michael Peterson, my electrocardiologist, called me Bullet Man because I told him several times that I had “dodged a bullet.” I had created a bit of a buzz in the hospital because of my amazing recovery from an event that only 5 percent of people survive.

On Monday, Feb. 16, I had an ICD implanted in my chest and connected to my heart. “Old Sparky” is

ready to deliver the necessary shock to my heart if ventricular fibrillation or cardiac arrest occurs. Tuesday it was time to go home. Many doctors, nurses, and other staff treated me during my 11 days at the hospital. It seemed they all came by to see me and share in my family’s joy that I was going to walk out of the hospital under my own power to resume a fairly normal life. There were lots of hugs and smiles.

It did take me a few days to get my strength back, and I did rest quite a bit at first. As the days went by, I realized how fortunate I was to survive my event with very few consequences. On Feb. 24, I returned to work on a part-time basis. After a couple of weeks, I resumed my full schedule, both at work and at home. I can honestly say that, outside of some minor issues with the ICD implant site, I am exactly where I was before my sudden cardiac arrest.

Today, I have a much greater respect for life and enjoy every day to the fullest. I will be forever grateful to the doctors and staff at United for their remarkable treatment and giving me such a great outcome. Every bit as important to me is the kind and compassionate way they treated my wife and family. They were never too busy to check in on them and make sure all of their questions were answered. My wife insisted that I be taken to United Hospital, and I am living proof that she made the right choice.

## United Hospital, United Heart and Vascular Imaging receive Echocardiography accreditation

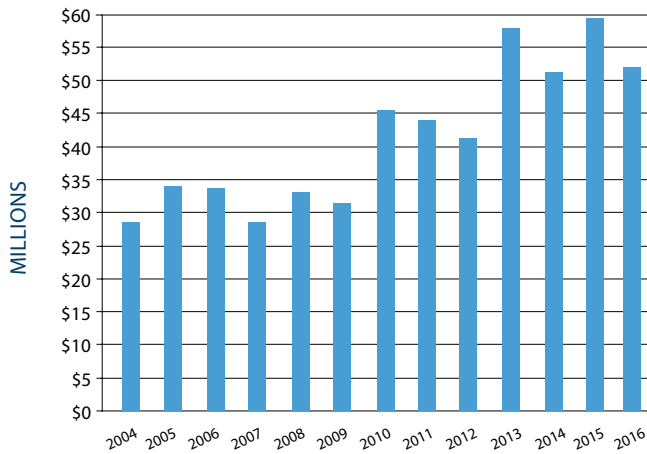
Cardiovascular diseases are the No. 1 cause of death in the United States. Early detection of life threatening heart disorders and other diseases is possible with Echocardiography. In December 2015, United Hospital, Cardiac Ultrasound, was accredited in Echocardiography in the three areas: Adult Transthoracic, Adult Transesophageal, Adult stress by the Intersocietal Accreditation Commission (ICA).

This accreditation, widely respected in the medical community, is a "seal of approval" that patients can rely on as an indication that the facility has been carefully reviewed on all aspects of its operations by medical experts in the Echocardiography field.

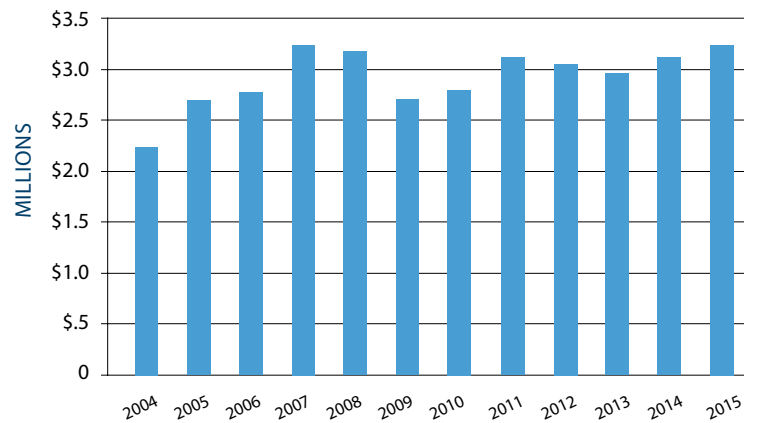

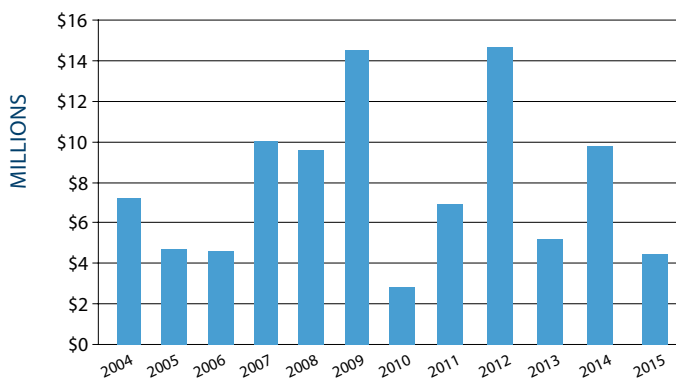
## Assets at Beginning of Year



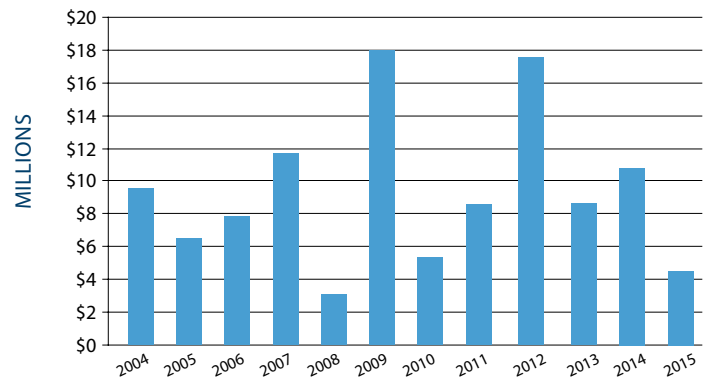
## Annual Giving



## Total Contributions

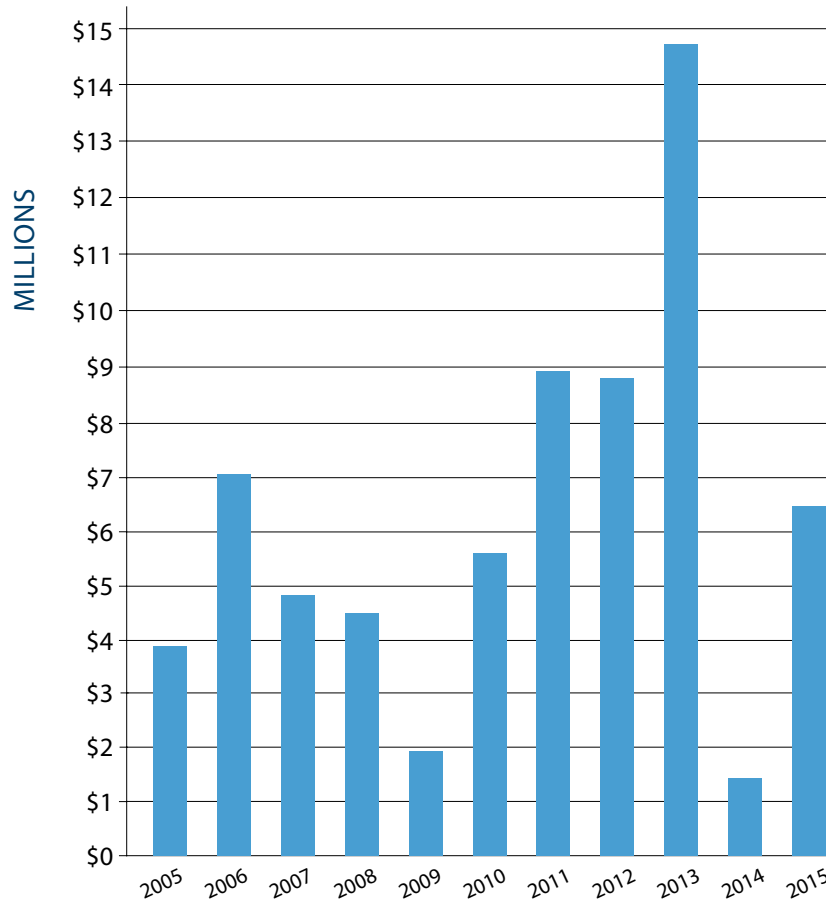


## Total Income

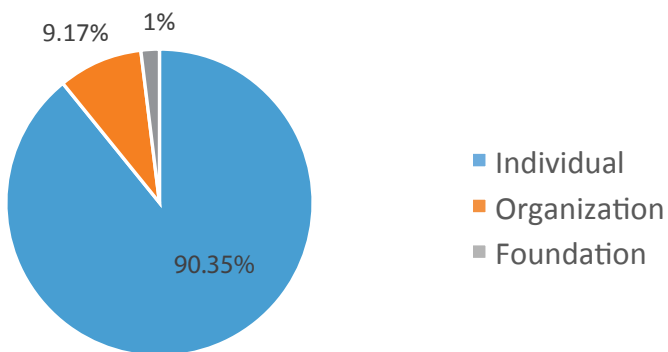




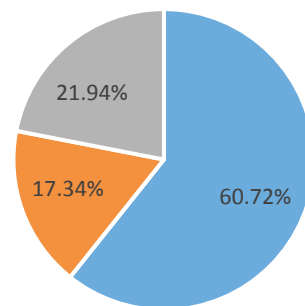

# Your Essential Health Care Directive

It was a terrible day. The day before Christmas and my wife was dying. Kathy had fallen into a deep sleep. It was clear that death was near. The United Hospital hospice nurse asked if I wanted to provide artificially administered nutrition. I grew up in Nebraska where food was an important part of every occasion. It was hard to imagine denying food to anyone. What helped me with these wrenching emotional decisions was that the hospice nurse had taken time to discuss Kathy's end-of-life choices. These were reduced to a Health Care Directive: one of the most important legal documents anyone can have. It addresses three health care issues:

**1. Living Will.** This says if I have a terminal illness, my death is imminent, and there is no realistic hope of recovery, then don't use heroic means to prolong my dying. It also addresses specific questions regarding desired treatments: Do you want tube feeding at a time you cannot swallow? Do you wish to be an organ donor? You may also speak to issues of religious faith, such as clergy visitation and last rites.

**2. Naming a Health Care Agent.** You, as the principal, designate an agent to make health care decisions when you cannot make them yourself. If you are attended by a physician, your doctor determines your decision-making ability. If you're not attended by a physician, your health care agent decides. It is critical to name the right person as health care agent; you need someone who is not too tender-hearted, and who can make hard decisions.

**3. HIPPA.** It is a violation of this federal law for a health care provider to share your medical records with anyone without your prior written consent. This means your spouse, children, friend, or life partner won't have access to your medical records absent your written consent. Likewise, if your child is older than eighteen, you have no legal right to participate in your child's health care, or access your child's medical records absent the child's written consent. Nothing human is perfect. While it's rare, mistakes occur. In such a case, your family needs your medical records. If a second opinion is needed, your records would be essential. Your health care directive provides your necessary consent.

Give a copy of your health care directive to your health care agent, your doctor, the hospital when you check in, and drop one in the glove compartment of your car, your suitcase when you travel, and keep one handy at the house in case of emergency. My experience with my wife's death convinced me that a health care directive is an indispensable legal document. Given the uncertainties of life, for you and your family, be certain you have one.
