Application Criteria

DONALD SANFORD NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

- Applicant must be majoring in nursing at a college or vocational school.
- Applicants entering first year or above of nursing school are considered.
- Applicant must live in Steele County or be an employee of the Owatonna Hospital, or the immediate family (spouse or dependent child) of the Owatonna Hospital employee.
- The Auxiliary's official Application Form must be completed.

OWATONNA HOSPITAL AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP

- Applicant must be majoring in a health-related field at a college, medical school or vocational school.
- Applicants entering their second year of school or above are considered.
- Applicant must live in Steele County or be an employee of the Owatonna Hospital, or the immediate family (spouse or dependent child) of the Owatonna Hospital employee.
- The Auxiliary's official Application Form must be completed.

To apply:

- Obtain and submit two (2) letters of recommendation.
- Obtain and submit high school and college transcripts (if you have completed at least one year of college you may submit college transcripts).
