COVID PANDEMIC STRETCHES OUR RESOURCES *We Need Your Help!*

The Health and Safety of our golfers, volunteers and staff brings cancellation of the 2020 Regina Classic

All Regina staff and resources have been vitally focused on managing the COVID-19 crisis. Because the environment surrounding COVID-19 produces much uncertainty for our sponsors, golfers, volunteers, vendors, as well as our planning team, we are sad to cancel the 2020 Regina Classic. This will be the first time in over 20 years that we have not held a golf tournament, but we truly believe that it is in the best health interest of the golfers, volunteers and our Foundation.

The challenge remains that the Regina Classic is our annual fund raising event, and the Regina Foundation is more dependent than ever on the generosity of our donors. The coronavirus has had a severe financial impact on health systems throughout the state, including Regina Hospital and Regina Senior Living. Elective surgeries and medical imaging procedures were postponed in order to conserve PPE for front-line caregivers and to reduce potential exposure for both health care workers and patients. Admissions are down in long term and transitional care, impacting the bottom line for senior living. This strategy to flatten the curve of illness is important, but the reduction in revenues and significant costs to acquire an unprecedented amount of supplies and equipment, build out temporary spaces for a surge of patients and ensure we have the right workforce in place to care for COVID-19 patients have made havoc of finances. ***We need your help more than ever!***

Regina Hospital and Regina Senior Living has rallied around a single goal: to provide the best health care possible in the midst of the coronavirus pandemic.

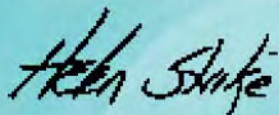
During this time of great need, we have seen how our communities are eager to rally around us with support and gratitude. We are grateful and overwhelmed by the outpouring of love and support.

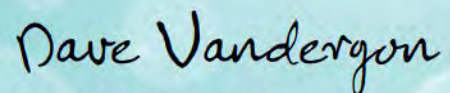

The Nu Step machine is an excellent addition at our therapy gym in Prescott. It has a higher weight capacity and allows us to serve a greater population as we start to see more patients in our Weight Management program.



The new hi/lo table was funded so we could provide a specific bladder cancer treatment in Regina's Cancer Center. This provides patients in our community a treatment option close to home. The bed adjusts up, down and sitting to keep each patient at their highest level of comfort and enables patients to easily transfer to and from the bed.



Code carts are strategically placed throughout the hospital and have necessary equipment and supplies to effectively respond to critical situations. The addition of this code cart increases response time to emergencies occurring in Medical Imaging and meets the trauma regulations set by the MN Department of Health.
