

# How to fill your prescriptions & stay healthy during the coronavirus pandemic

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**At Allina Health, we are committed to your health and well-being. We know that getting your prescriptions is an important part of your wellness journey.**

**Here are some ideas for getting your medications quickly and safely during this time.**

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- Call ahead or use **online portals** to make sure all your prescriptions are ready. Use **automated systems** (text, apps etc.) as much as possible.
  - Try to have **all your prescriptions filled** at one time and for a **90-day supply** if insurance allows. This helps prevent extra trips to the pharmacy.
  - Have **prescriptions filled 5-7 days before** you will be out, especially if you are out of refills. Contact the pharmacy and they will contact the doctor.
  - Pharmacies can sometimes fill a short supply in an emergency if you are out of refills, but it is better to give the pharmacy time to get a new prescription from the doctor.
  - It is best to **have prescriptions mailed** to you. Most pharmacies will mail for free. They just need a form of payment on file for co-pays, which can be done over the phone.
  - If you go to the pharmacy, **use the drive thru or ask for curbside pickup.**
  - **Try to avoid going into the pharmacy to protect yourself & the pharmacy team.**
  - Many pharmacies can sell small **over-the-counter medications** via mail or the drive thru.
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## Special hours for local pharmacies

The following are general pharmacy hours, but may differ from store to store. **It is best to call your store to determine their hours of operation.** These hours are for the pharmacy, not the store the pharmacy is in, which may be longer in some cases. Most pharmacies have continued normal business hours or extended hours as needed.

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**Allina Health Pharmacy:** Normal pharmacy hours. Allina Health Heart Hospital Pharmacy is open 24/7. Will mail prescriptions for free. **Cub Pharmacy:** Extended hours at some locations (Blaine, Maple Grove, Midway, Stillwater): 7 a.m.-10 p.m. Other locations have normal hours: weekdays, 9 a.m.-9 p.m. and Saturday-Sunday, 9 a.m.-6 p.m. [cub.com/pharmacy.html](https://cub.com/pharmacy.html)

**CVS:** Normal pharmacy hours. Typically open weekdays, 9 a.m.-8 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m.-6 p.m.; Sunday, 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Free delivery of medications and everyday essentials in 1-2 days. [cvs.com/content/delivery](https://cvs.com/content/delivery)

**CVS Target:** Senior hour is the first hour of day on Wednesdays. Normal pharmacy hours.

**Genoa:** Normal pharmacy hours but varies by location. Mail and delivery service available. [genoahealthcare.com/locations/minnesota/](https://genoahealthcare.com/locations/minnesota/)

**Hy-Vee Pharmacy:** New hours: 8 a.m.-8 p.m. [hy-vee.com/my-pharmacy](https://hy-vee.com/my-pharmacy)

**Lloyd's Pharmacy:** Normal pharmacy hours. Will mail prescriptions. Text messaging service for refills. [loydsrx.com/services](https://loydsrx.com/services)

**Setzer Pharmacy:** Normal pharmacy hours. Mail and local delivery. Text messaging service for refills. [setzerrx.com/services](https://setzerrx.com/services)

**Seward Pharmacy:** Normal pharmacy hours. Will deliver medications locally. [sewardpharmacy.com/](https://sewardpharmacy.com/)

**Walmart Pharmacy:** Senior hour is Tuesdays, one hour before normal pharmacy opening time. [walmart.com/cp/pharmacy/5431](https://walmart.com/cp/pharmacy/5431)

**Walgreens:** Most stores are open 9 a.m.-9 p.m. weekdays. At 24-hour stores, drive-thru only overnight 9 p.m.-9 a.m. Senior hours are Tuesday from 8-9 a.m. for the store. Also offering mailed service by express delivery next day. Text "Joinrx" to 21525. [walgreens.com/](https://walgreens.com/)

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
