By the numbers:

In 2023, an ambulance was requested every 42 seconds in the state of Minnesota.

- 102,441 scene responses for 911 calls
 - 73,109 Transports
- 426 Community Special Events
- Support Events for our First Responders
 - 1018 Fire Standbys
 - 173 Police Standbys
- 17,685 hours of EMS student shadowing on ambulances from the following:

341,583 phone calls processed by our EMS Communications Center, an Accredited Center of Excellence by the International Academies of Emergency Dispatch.

Our team, who are certified Emergency Medical Dispatchers, have completed Emergency Mental Health Dispatch training and are responsible for:

- answering 911 calls transferred for pre-arrival instructions including:
 - CPR instructions
 - aspirin administration for chest pain
 - assisting with imminent delivery of a baby
- dispatching and monitoring radio transmissions
 - identifying and providing resources prior to and during responses
- providing on-site special event dispatch services

Our vehicles:

- 85 ambulances
- 4.3 million miles traveled






