

## **Media Statement | SEIU Doctors Council (Primary Care) Strike Authorization Vote | 3.6.26**

Allina Health is disappointed that Doctors Council SEIU again pursued a strike authorization vote in primary and urgent care. While this action does not guarantee a strike, it shifts focus away from the meaningful progress that continues at the bargaining table.

We continue to negotiate in good faith toward a fair, sustainable agreement that provides competitive compensation and benefits for our providers. Our commitment remains the same: supporting our providers while protecting access to affordable care for the patients and communities we serve. We look forward to continuing negotiations at our next session on March 16.
