Opportunities to support Nursing Excellence

- Scholarships: Responding to an industry standard for nurses to achieve a higher level of education, scholarships allow current nurses to pursue advanced education including baccalaureate and graduate degrees. Through a valued partnership with St. Catherine University, nurses with a two-year degree can efficiently complete a four-year degree, bringing their advanced knowledge and skills back to the bedside. Scholarships remove the financial barrier for our nursing staff to keep pace with their colleagues nationally.
- Nurse-led research: With their unique perspective, nurses are often best positioned to identify opportunities to improve patient care. Evidence-based practice research and fellowships give nurses the time and mentorship support to study and develop solutions that enhance patient outcomes and experience. For example, nurses conducted research that identified the most accurate and least intrusive way to measure body temperature, and another study is measuring the impact of acupuncture on reducing pain and anxiety after surgery. Through the research process, patient care improves and nurses gain important practical skills. Philanthropy makes this happen.
- **Ongoing education:** The health care environment is constantly evolving with new therapies, techniques and procedures always in development. Abbott Northwestern nurses must pursue certifications, attend conferences and engage in professional development to ensure that they can perform at the top of their license and continue delivering the best patient care possible.
