Opportunities to support the Orthopedic Institute

Research: Orthopedic leaders, motivated by a commitment to improve outcomes, are focused on patient-centered research. Piloting techniques for less invasive surgeries, testing new post-surgical treatments and studying the impact of innovative therapies on recovery are a few examples of how research can improve care and outcomes. Philanthropy will support new discoveries and contribute to the rapidly advancing field of orthopedics.

Equipment: Innovative techniques within orthopedic surgery and treatment are emerging every day, providing opportunities for patients to heal better and faster. Philanthropy will support tools and equipment to improve operating room capabilities, reduce surgery time and enhance care for patients.

Integrative therapies: Studies show that integrative therapies such as acupuncture help patients get back to their lives faster.
