Opportunities to support Virginia Piper Cancer Institute

- Patient programs: A cancer diagnosis begins what can be a difficult and overwhelming journey. Innovative treatment and supportive resources focus on the patient and his or her family to ensure the best possible outcomes. A prime example is the cancer care coordinator, a specially trained nurse who is a constant presence to answer questions, make appointments and provide support. Additionally, acupuncture and aromatherapy are used to lessen anxiety and pain during and after procedures. Social workers are available to help parents talk about a cancer diagnosis with their children. Philanthropy ensures that these and other patient-centered programs continue.
- Research and prevention: Physician leaders are involved in two research areas that have the potential to change the course of cancer: precision medicine which attacks the cancer at the genetic level, and immuno-oncology which uses the body's own immune system to find and fight cancer. Additional studies focus on other cancers, such as liver and pancreatic cancer, to develop new tests for early detection. Philanthropy ensures that we can continue to advance our understanding of cancer and how to eliminate it.
