# Announcing the John Nasseff Neuroscience Institute at Allina Health

The neuroscience program of Allina Health has been named the *John Nasseff Neuroscience Institute* to honor a generous philanthropic gift from John Nasseff.

"Mr. Nasseff's gift is transformational," said Steven Swanson, MD, president of the John Nasseff Neuroscience Institute. "It will help us enhance our neurosciences program, offering patients outstanding care and great outcomes, delivered with professionalism."

As the American population ages, neurological disorders are increasing as the cause of disability and death. Each year more than 100,000 people from Minnesota, Wisconsin, and surrounding regions receive neurological care at an Allina Health facility.

According to Dr. Swanson, creating a complete, comprehensive system of care is the goal of the Nasseff gift. Through the John Nasseff Neuroscience Institute, Allina Health, along with physician partners, will enhance treatment of patients for neurological conditions such as stroke, tumors of the brain and spinal cord, epilepsy, Alzheimer's disease, balance and movement disorders, headaches and sleep disorders.

Neuroscience patients seek care at Allina Health facilities in many places—from small towns to the Twin Cities area. It's important to structure the system so they receive appropriate, timely care no matter where they begin, Dr. Swanson explained.

Allina Health has made strides in recent years to improve care for people who have had a stroke. Through the Allina Health telestroke program, a doctor who specializes in neurology is available via video connection to see and interact with stroke patients in the emergency rooms of 16 regional hospitals. In communities from Litchfield to Baldwin, Wis., patients receive expert evaluations from neurologists who are based at United and Abbott Northwestern hospitals.

This allows treatment to begin rapidly in the local hospitals or for patients to be transferred promptly for specialized care. Time is critical for stroke patients, so that treatments can restore blood flow to the brain and limit the damage.

diagnosis and treatment of neurological disorders.

For example, brain aneurysms, which release blood into the brain and can be fatal, weren't considered treatable until recent years. Now, interventional neuroradiologists use minimally invasive procedures to treat aneurysms in most patients, saving lives and dramatically reducing disability, Dr. Swanson said.

Surgery for patients with brain tumors is another area of progress. Thanks to equipment that allows for MRI scans during surgery, "our surgeries are more effective and safer," Dr. Swanson noted. United's first intraoperative MRI equipment was acquired in 2006, provided by donors' gifts to United Hospital Foundation.

"The east metro area community has benefited from John Nasseff's generosity for many years," said Duke Adamski, president of United Hospital Foundation. "He has made such significant contributions to advance care at United Hospital. We have been fortunate to have him as an advocate and longtime friend. Now, we are excited about the difference that his donation can make for enhancing neurology care and benefitting even more people who are served by Allina Health."

# When the Unexpected Happens

## Jaime Anderson, 25, Works Hard to Recover from Stroke



Jaime Anderson is rebuilding her life with extensive therapy and a positive attitude.

Given all she's been through, Jaime Anderson could be forgiven for asking, "Why me?"

In August 2012 Jaime, 25, had a massive stroke. Within the next two months she had three neurosurgeries at United Hospital. Then she started intensive therapy to relearn basic things like holding up her head. Her recovery continues this

spring, as she undertakes rigorous exercise therapy at Courage Center.

Dwelling on "Why me?" isn't her style. "If I felt sorry for myself all the time, I wouldn't get anything done," she explained.

Jaime's experience highlights the excellent care that United provides for patients with neurological disorders. Her parents credit United's doctors and nurses with saving her life in the anxiety-filled days after her stroke.

"Even though having this happen to our daughter was a terrible experience, everyone at United made it the best it could be," said Bruce, Jaime's father. "We are extremely grateful."

## Family Chooses United for Emergency Care

Last summer Jaime moved back to the Twin Cities after working for three years in New Orleans. She started a new job at the Target corporate office in Minneapolis, rented an apartment with friends and enjoyed spending time with her family. On Aug. 22 her parents arranged to pick up Jaime, then go to dinner to celebrate her sister's birthday. After repeatedly knocking on Jaime's apartment door and phoning with no answer, the Andersons grew panicky. The landlord happened to come by, and she let them into Jaime's apartment.

Jaime's mother Ann found her on the bedroom floor. laime couldn't move.

Ann, a surgical nurse, called 911 and directed the paramedics to take her daughter to United. The staff at the Peter J. King Emergency Care Center worked quickly to discover what was wrong. When her parents arrived, Jaime was already receiving a CT scan of her head in the emergency department's imaging center.

During the scan Jaime heard a doctor say, "I found it." Later, Jaime understood that meant he saw the blockage that caused a massive stroke. "At the time I thought, 'Don't shave my head!" she recalled.

Meanwhile, the Andersons learned Jaime's serious diagnosis. Her carotid artery, which brings blood to the brain, had become blocked, depriving part of her brain. The Andersons were mystified, because Jaime had no risk factors for a stroke.

## **Life-saving Neurosurgery**

Jaime was transferred to United's neuro intensive care unit, where staff members specialize in caring for patients with strokes and serious neurological problems. Her family began a long vigil at United, setting up a base in a waiting room. Doctors told them the next 96 hours would be crucial, because Jaime's injured brain would swell.

To create room for swelling, Jaime underwent surgery the next morning by neurosurgeon Jerone Kennedy, MD, who removed a flap of her skull. Although the surgery "is life-saving," it couldn't heal damage caused by the stroke, explained Dr. Kennedy, of United Neurosurgery Associates.

The next few days Jaime's condition worsened. She

needed a second brain surgery, this time to remove the damaged portion of her brain along with a larger piece of the skull. The six-hour surgery, which started at 10 p.m. on a Friday night, was performed by Mary Elizabeth Dunn, MD, also of United Neurosurgery Associates.

### First Steps on the Road to Recovery

Fortunately, Jaime slowly started to recover after the second surgery. Even though she couldn't move, her family was happy that she could squeeze their hands. She used a small stuffed dog to communicate, shaking its head for yes or no. The Andersons got an OK to bring their dog Duke to visit Jaime several times, which she loved.

Jaime was unable to sit up or even hold up her head. A week after her stroke, "It was very difficult, because no one could tell us what would happen to Jaime," Ann said. "We were told that young and healthy people like Jaime do the best."

After two and a half weeks at United, Jaime transferred to Bethesda Hospital for its rehabilitation program. She arrived there in a wheelchair, wearing a neck brace to hold up her head and unable to use her left leg and

In October she returned to United for another surgery by Dr. Kennedy, this time to restore the piece of bone to her skull.

Then she started a three-month stay at Courage Center in Golden Valley, learning to move again and regain independence, one task at a time.

### Jaime's 'Exceptional Progress'

"Learning to walk again, without holding onto anything, was so hard!" Jaime exclaimed. "I was very shaky and uncertain, and I was afraid of falling." Slowly, she regained her ability to do things for herself, like dressing.

Her parents credited Jaime's determination to work hard. "laime really puts effort into her recovery. All of her doctors and therapists comment about her hard work," Bruce said.

This spring, Jaime is participating in Courage Center's ABLE program, a rigorous and highly individualized exercise program to maximize her recovery. She is also working with Courage Center specialists on skills to return to her job. Her brain injury created challenges in processing visual and spatial information, so she's learning to compensate for that.

Early in her recovery process, Jaime received physical and occupational therapy at Sister Kenny® Rehabilitation Institute - United Hospital, coordinated by Diane Chappuis, MD, a specialist in physical medicine and rehabilitation. Dr. Chappuis also continues to direct Jaime's therapies at Courage Center. (See article on page 35.)

One thing is sure about Jaime's recovery: Everyone she meets is impressed with her progress.

"I continue to be amazed by Jaime's recovery," said Dr. Kennedy. "She is quite exceptional. Some people get back more than we would have thought, and Jaime is a good example. At Jaime's appointment two months after her surgery, she was using her smart phone and Tweeting. The old Jaime was there, with the same personality."

United Hospital is certified as a Primary Stroke Center. United's staff ranks highly in providing rapid and effective care for stroke patients.

## Ready to Treat Stroke

## United's Rapid Emergency Care Saves Lives

When it comes to helping patients who've had a stroke, staff members in the Peter J. King Emergency Care Center at United Hospital make every minute count.

A stroke disrupts blood flow in the brain. It is crucial that blood flow is quickly restored before permanent damage to the brain

occurs. Rapid treatment not only saves lives, it reduces the disabling effects of stroke.

The Peter J. King Emergency Care Center exceeds national standards for quickly diagnosing and treating stroke patients, with many gains made by a dedicated team led by United emergency medicine physician Sandy Fritzlar, MD.

"We have created a process that is reliable and efficient, making sure all necessary resources are available quickly when these critically ill patients arrive in our emergency department," Dr. Fritzlar said.

A complex set of steps is required to diagnosis and treat stroke. In the last two years the emergency department's stroke team has reworked every aspect of care.

## **Critical Timing to Help Stroke Patients**

Each patient with neurological symptoms who arrives at the Peter J. King Emergency Care Center is now screened for stroke and quickly seen by a nurse and emergency medicine physician.

With a diagnosis of stroke, the team rapidly takes action. In quick succession, lab tests are drawn and analyzed, a CT scan is performed, and the neurologist is contacted. Preparation of medications in the pharmacy is also started.

Time is critical because the clot-busting medication tPA can be given only within 4.5 hours after the stroke. In 2012, eligible patients at United received tPA in an average of 45 minutes, well below the national standard of 60 minutes. United's fastest time is 29 minutes.

Many stroke patients arrive too late for tPA. Another treatment may be used, in which an interventional radiologist removes the blood clot through a catheter, restoring the blood flow.

Dr. Fritzlar and the stroke team study each stroke patient's treatment in the Peter J. King Emergency Care Center, constantly looking for ways to improve. "Every single person has to do this right," she explained. "Our staff takes a lot of pride in taking care of all of our patients, especially patients who need life-saving interventions like this."

United relies on key physician partners in caring for stroke patients, including Emergency Care Consultants, St. Paul Radiology, Neurological Associates, United Neurosurgery Associates, Allina Medical Clinic - United Hospitalist Service, and Sister Kenny® Rehabilitation Institute.

### Hats Off to Donors

Peter J. King Emergency Care Center's CT Scanner Leads to Faster Treatment

Thanks to donors, improvements in the new Peter J. King Emergency Care Center contribute to faster care for patients with stroke.

The \$24 million emergency care center, which opened in April 2011, was largely funded by donors. Among its improvements is a CT scanner located in the emergency department, which provides essential information for stroke diagnosis and treatment.


"Stroke patients never have to leave our emergency department for a CT scan," said Sandy Fritzlar, MD, emergency medicine physician. "This resource allows all of our critically ill patients to be closely monitored by ED nurses and physicians at all times."

# St. Paul Lung Clinic/Pulmonary and Critical Care Associates to join Allina Health

St. Paul Lung Clinic/Pulmonary and Critical Care Associates (PCCA) will officially join Allina Health in July 2013. This integration is part of the effort to expand and enhance specialty care in the east metro area and western Wisconsin.

The physicians and their support teams have been an integral part of the health care community for more than 35 years.

This integration was announced in March by Tom O'Connor, president of United Hospital, Mike Marshall, MD, president of Allina Health Clinics, and Anuja Sharma, MD, president of St. Paul Lung Clinic/PCCA. "This partnership will allow us to enhance what we already do well: provide exceptional pulmonary and critical care to the communities we serve," their announcement stated.

As part of the integration, the St. Paul Lung Clinic will become Allina Health United Lung & Sleep Clinic. The physicians and support staff will be employed by Allina Health, and work is ongoing to ensure a smooth transition for patients. The transition is expected to begin in July and continue through the summer.

"The decision to integrate with Allina Health is the beginning of an exciting new era of delivering pulmonary, sleep and critical care services," the announcement stated. "St. Paul Lung Clinic/PCCA is looking forward to increasing its presence at United Hospital, providing additional intensivists coverage, and focusing efforts toward innovative care models and superior clinical outcomes in both inpatient and outpatient settings."

In 2011, PCCA was recognized by United Hospital Foundation as the Service to Humanity physician honorees.

At United, PCCA physicians and nurse practitioners attend patients in intensive care units (ICUs) and assist other physicians in the management of lung disease. In the ICUs, PCCA physicians lead multidisciplinary rounds on every critically ill patient each morning, ensuring effective communication among the many staff members who provide complex care for these patients.

PCCA staff members also see ICU patients for whom specialty consultation has been requested, for services such as management of shock, ventilator management, and procedures including intubation and the placement of venous and arterial lines.

On medical units and in the ICUs, PCCA specialists manage patients with asthma, COPD (emphysema), lung cancer and pnenumonia. They also assist in the management of patients after heart or lung surgery.

# Richards Appointed as United VP

Amanda (Mandy) Richards has been named as vice president, Patient Care, at United Hospital. She will begin her service on May 1.

Richards, a clinical nurse specialist, has been serving in the Allina Health Neuroscience Clinical Service Line as the director of Clinical Programs. (The neuroscience program was recently renamed the John Nasseff Neuroscience Institute.) She worked on Neuroscience and Spine clinical program development and implementation of best practices, such as standardized stroke care, nursing care coordination, and clinical education.

"The addition of Mandy to United's leadership team is one of many steps we are taking to pursue our strategic vision for patient care innovation and integration," said Tom O'Connor, United president.

Prior to her service line work, Richards was the director of Patient Care — Neuroscience Institute, Intensive Care,



# Progress Continues on Construction of Elaine S. Larson Surgical Center


Construction of the Elaine S. Larson Surgical Center reached its halfway mark in Spring 2013 with completion of many new areas including three operating rooms; post-anesthesia care unit; pharmacy; pathology department and renovated physician lounge.

"The new Elaine S. Larson Surgical Center is really starting to take shape, and staff members are excited to be caring for patients in these new spaces. The new operating rooms are not only larger, but also reflect recommendations from surgeons and staff on how to best design the space for surgeries. Throughout the construction, staff members have played an integral part ensuring the Elaine S. Larson

Surgical Center will not only best serve our patients today, but also meet future needs," said Sarah Held, RN, director, Surgical Services.

The Elaine S. Larson Surgical Center will provide 15 new operating rooms, for a total of 18. Other improvements include: larger areas for patients before and after surgery; comfortable space in the family waiting areas; pathology and histology offices; and a larger physician lounge. Construction will be completed in January 2014.

## In Memory of Leonard Wilkening

Leonard Wilkening, a member of the United Hospital Foundation board of directors since 1991, died on Jan. 9, 2013.

Wilkening, 87, a St. Paul resident since 1968, was devoted to community service. He served as president and CEO of the Amherst H. Wilder Foundation from 1971 to 1990. At the time Wilkening retired, the Wilder Foundation operated 45 human service programs in the St. Paul area, serving more than 16,000 persons a year.

He was active on many community boards and committees during his service at Wilder and in retirement. Wilkening was instrumental in founding Como Friends, the nonprofit organization that supports the Como Park Zoo and Conservatory. Wilkening served on the boards of directors of the Minnesota Foundation and the St. Paul Area Council of Churches and chaired the Child Care Partnership of Ramsey County.

He provided consulting services to many agencies, including the Deafness Education and Advocacy Foundation. In addition, Wilkening served on Saint Paul Tomorrow and on committees for the Saint Paul Foundation. He was an active member of Hamline United Methodist Church.

Wilkening started his career in social services with six YMCA organizations in lowa and Ohio. He and his wife Jean had four children, five grandchildren, and one great-granddaughter. His longtime best friend and companion is Norrine Bohman.

# Bentson Neurological Same Stay Unit to Open This Fall

Work is underway at United Hospital to build a new unit for neurological patients. The Bentson Neurological Same Stay Unit will open in October, funded by a generous donation from the Bentson Foundation.

The unit will consolidate care that is now given in the intensive care, step-down, and neurological units. Patients will benefit by spending their hospital stay in a single unit that has been specially designed for neurological care. For example, people who have had spinal cord injuries or strokes are among those who will be served on the Bentson Neurological Same Stay Unit.

The new unit will feature new monitoring and diagnostic technology. Critically ill patients will be able to have imaging tests on the unit, avoiding transport to the radiology department.

The patient care manager for the new unit is Mark Chlebeck, RN, who has experience in United's intensive care unit and a leadership position in the orthopedics unit. So far, 20 nurses have been hired to work on the unit.

Construction of the unit started in March. During the winter, staff and designers evaluated a mock-up of a neurological intensive care room for proper function and flow.






### **Total Contributions**







# **Nasseff Mechanical Contractors: Builders and Donors at United**

Many key buildings at United Hospital display quality workmanship performed by employees of Nasseff Mechanical Contractors.

Nasseff Mechanical is a St. Paul firm that offers a full range of mechanical services, from plumbing and HVAC (heating, ventilation, and air conditioning) to fire protection. The firm also participates in United's mission as a donor to United Hospital Foundation (UHF), supporting the hospital since 2005.

The late John M. "Mickey" Nasseff Jr. started the company in 1972 in his Oakdale home. A plumber, Nasseff quickly expanded the business into a broad array of mechanical services. Nasseff moved the company to St. Paul in 2002. Today, the company employs 70 people on building projects throughout the metro area. Mickey Nasseff is the son of John Nasseff Sr., a major donor to UHF.

The company went through an unexpected transition in 2012, when Nasseff, 68, died tragically in a singlevehicle motorcycle accident in July. Jeff Ulrich, who had served as vice president, became president in September 2012.

Nasseff Mechanical has been proud to participate in constructing the United campus and supporting United as a donor, Ulrich said. "Mickey was very fond of the relationship that the Nasseff family has had with United Hospital, and he wanted to carry that out through Nasseff Mechanical."

Many Nasseff Mechanical employees live in the east metro area, and they view United "as an essential part of the community," Ulrich noted. "We take pride in our long-term relationship with our customers, employees, and also the community."

Nasseff Mechanical is currently performing mechanical work on the Elaine S. Larson Surgical Center at United, which will open early next year. It also worked on the Peter J. King Emergency Care Center, Nasseff Specialty Center, John Nasseff Neuroscience Institute, and United Family Practice Center.

Construction at United demands close cooperation among the hospital staff, the architectural and engineering firm HDR, the building contractor McGough, and Nasseff Mechanical, Ulrich said. "In the surgery center construction there are many systems involved in the mechanical and electrical side. We participate in a lot of planning to ensure that we keep the surgery suites up and running while we build," he said. "We work very well as a team."

# Louis Fors Hill: Continuing a Family's History with United

The family of Louis Fors Hill, United Hospital, and the city of St. Paul share a dense web of connections.

Hill, a member of the board of directors of United Hospital Foundation (UHF), belongs to a legendary St. Paul family. His great-grandfather was James J. Hill, builder of the Great Northern Railway and an entrepreneur who was instrumental in the growth of the Upper Midwest, the Great Plains, and the Pacific Northwest.

Louis Hill's service to United began in the 1980s, when he served for 12 years on the United Hospital board of trustees, including three years as chairman. Hill joined the foundation board of directors in 1992.

Hill enjoys telling about his family's ties to United and St. Paul, which date back 160 years.

James J. Hill came to St. Paul from Ontario as a teenager in the 1850s, starting as

a clerk for a steamboat company. His boardinghouse roommate for a time was Charles T. Miller, who went on to make his fortune in land and lumber.

After Miller's death, his widow made a donation to establish the Charles T. Miller Hospital in St. Paul. (Miller and St. Luke's Hospitals consolidated to form United in 1972.)

The Hill family has long supported both Miller and United. Hill's grandmother Maud donated \$50,000 in the 1950s to support the Research Fund at Miller, he said. "The Research Fund is a predecessor organization to the United Hospital Foundation," Hill explained.

While Hill was growing up in St. Paul, his mother Elsi was active in the Women's Auxiliary at Miller, then United. Elsi, with her friends Grace Beek, Patty Worthing and Clara Harris, ran the hospital gift shop, which was originally staffed by volunteers.

After graduating from the University of Minnesota, Hill worked in the family's foundry, mining, and timber businesses. He lived in Oregon for 12 years, then returned to Minnesota.

He serves as president of Rockwood Capital Management, which manages the Hill family assets, and also leads several other family-owned businesses. Hill chairs the Grotto Foundation, one of the Hill family's foundations. He served on a number of nonprofit boards, including Hazelden Foundation, Hamline University, and the Minnesota Council on Quality.

At United, Hill has lent his expertise in finances and investments. He's seen the tremendous impact of forward-thinking physicians at United, whose visions for improved care have been made possible by key donors. "United would not be its present size without philanthropy," he said.

Hill firmly believes in the power of philanthropy in America. "The United States is the most philanthropic country in the world," he said. "We do things differently here."

# Patrick Mazorol: Focusing on Donors' Interests, United's Needs

Patrick Mazorol brings a wealth of skills to the board of directors of the United Hospital Foundation (UHF). His executive experience includes law, financial services, fundraising and nonprofit administration, plus a term as a state legislator.


An attorney, Mazorol started his career in private practice. Among his services were estate planning and advice for clients on making charitable donations.

Mazorol held three executive positions in his 20-plus years in the financial services industry. Most recently, he was the CEO of Securian Trust Company in St. Paul. Since 2010, he has served as the senior vice president for university relations at Bethel University in Arden Hills. As a member of Bethel's senior leadership team, he oversees its development department, Bethel Foundation, and works with the foundation board and the university's constituent relations department.

"I work with major donors, corporations, and foundations that give to Bethel University and oversee management, reporting, and investment of their gifts," he explained. "My background in law and financial services definitely plays into my work at Bethel."

On UHF's gift acceptance committee, Mazorol brings his expertise in meshing donors' interests with the foundation's responsibilities. The committee advises the board on non-cash gifts such as real estate, assuring that the foundation's policies for owning, managing and selling such assets are followed.

In addition, Mazorol serves on the UHF investment committee. "We know that donors are interested in safeguarding the foundation's assets and maintaining funds for the purpose for which they were given. Those are key things we address," he noted.

A resident of Bloomington, Mazorol served in the Minnesota House of Representatives from 2011 to early January 2013, representing areas of Bloomington and Edina. Among his accomplishments was serving as vice chair of the Judiciary Committee, which set policies and budgets for the state court system.

Mazorol said his legislative experience gave him a new appreciation for philanthropy's role in funding the staff, facilities and equipment that create excellent health care at United. He highlighted these donor-funded renovations: the Peter J. King Emergency Care Center; and the Elaine S. Larson Surgical Center, which will open in 2014.

He looks forward to greater support for health care charities like UHF. "People tend to become engaged in philanthropy where they see the need," Mazorol said. "With our aging population, more and more people need health care. Health care as a charity will move to the top of the list."



## New Observation Unit Enhances Emergency Care

United Hospital opened a new observation unit for patients from the Peter J. King Emergency Care Center in February 2013.

"This 12-bed unit, which is adjacent to the emergency department (ED), allows us to provide seamless and consistent care for patients who need observation, but don't need to be admitted," said Steve Horstmann, patient care director who manages the ED.

Patients are clinically evaluated for up to 16 to 18 hours to determine whether discharge or admission is appropriate. They are cared for by registered nurses from the ED and United's hospitalist physicians.

"We are confident this new unit will enable us to streamline the flow of patients in the emergency department, allowing us to provide the right type of care at the right time," Horstmann explained.

Hospitals around the nation have seen a dramatic rise in the use of observation for patients as an alternative to hospital admission.

# Emergency Department Continues to Serve More Patients, Faster

The Peter J. King Emergency Care Center at United Hospital continues to serve more patients each year.

United's Emergency Department (ED) was renovated in 2011 to give patients faster, easier access to emergency care. The \$24 million renovation, funded by donations, created more space, upgraded technology, and enhanced United's ability to respond to a major emergency in the community.

In 2012, the ED served 11 percent more patients than the previous year, for a total of 52,378. Since 2010, numbers of ED patients have increased 32 percent.

The new ED is meeting its goal of serving patients more quickly. After a patient arrives, "We get the patient into a treatment room in less than five minutes, on average," said Steve Horstmann, patient care director. The patient then sees a health care provider in less than 10 minutes. These waiting times rank United very highly among EDs in Minnesota and the United States.

Patients are responding favorably, with a 15 percent improvement in surveys of patient satisfaction in 2012.

Patients can learn the current waiting time in the ED from their mobile phones or computers on the home page of United's website (unitedhospital.com). The ED waiting time is updated every 15 minutes.

# Sister Kenny® Rehabilitation Institute and Courage Center Announce Merger

In a bold move to advance the care and services for the disability community, the Sister Kenny® Rehabilitation Institute and Courage Center will merge in summer 2013. The integration of these longstanding pillars of the health care rehabilitation community will create a leading, integrated service for individuals and families dealing with disabilities.

Sister Kenny and the Courage Center have long histories of advocating for the health and well-being of people with disabilities. The partnership will allow full integration of the two organizations with individuals and families benefitting from streamlined, coordinated services. This will be a uniquely comprehensive continuum of care including inpatient, outpatient and community-based rehabilitation services designed to keep people healthy and independent.

Courage Center's clinical programs will merge with those of Sister Kenny, and the organizations will look for opportunities to integrate clinical care, community-based services, research, innovation, public policy and advocacy.

"We are thrilled about what the coordinated strengths of our organizations will mean to the community," said Penny Wheeler, MD, chief clinical officer of Allina Health. "By combining the two, we blend the clinical care expertise of Sister Kenny with the exceptional programming, advocacy and community programs of Courage Center. In doing so, we can coordinate care, improve health and positively affect the lives of people with disabilities."

"As an advocate on behalf of people with disabilities, we recognize that one of the challenges our clients face is a fragmented system of rehabilitation services that is hard for both clients and providers to navigate. By partnering to create a more seamless experience, we will make it easier for our clients to get the care they need, which is key to improving outcomes," said Jan Malcolm, chief executive officer of Courage Center.



# United Reaches Out to Improve Health

How can United Hospital help the communities it serves enjoy better health?

That's the challenge that United will address in 2013, as part of the Affordable Care Act, the federal health reform law. The law requires each hospital to perform a community health needs assessment, then create a plan for how to improve community health.

"This is more than just a part of an ongoing conversation with the Internal Revenue Service around hospitals maintaining their nonprofit status," said Heather Peterson, community engagement director for the east metro region of Allina Health. "It's truly about United's long-standing commitment to improve community health by partnering with community members and listening to their needs and ideas to promote health and prevent disease." She noted that hospitals have long reported on the benefits they provide to the community.

United's activities to conduct the needs assessment started in 2012, with an extensive review of available data and two sessions in which representatives from community agencies reviewed health data, specific to the metro area.

Joining the discussion, which focused on underserved groups, were staff from the St. Paul-Ramsey County departments of health and public housing, Amherst H. Wilder Foundation, Neighborhood House, West Seventh Community Center, and a wide variety of other communitybased, non-profit program and service providers. In 2010, United also hosted community health dialogues, which helped guide the current discussion and partnerships.

Participants identified three potential areas of focus for United: obesity, lack of physical activity, and access to health care. In February and March 2013, residents shared their perspectives on these issues and offered ideas about what United could do to address these community health needs.

"A plan for how United will address community health improvement issues in the St. Paul community will be assembled later this year," Peterson said.



# Celebrating the Hearts of Women

Mothers, daughters, granddaughters and friends came together to recognize American Heart Month at the Celebrating the Hearts of Women Tea hosted by the United Hospital Foundation on Feb. 12.

More than 95 women attended the English Tea, held at The Saint Paul Hotel, to learn about the signs and risk factors associated with heart disease and other heart health tips specific to women. Guest presenters were Elizabeth Touhy, MD, cardiologist at United Heart & Vascular Clinic (UHVC), and Maureen Doran, nutritionist. In addition, attendees learned of the programs and services available through the Nasseff Heart Center at United Hospital and UHVC.

United and UHVC are proud to rank in the top 10 percent of hospitals in the nation for opening blocked arteries in the heart quickly. The faster a patient's arteries are opened, the greater chance for reducing heart damage and recovering successfully. This is just one of many remarkable achievements that showcase the quality partnerships, dedicated staff and state-of-the-art techniques that make the Nasseff Heart Center a state and national leader in heart care.

# Clinic Opens for Women at High Risk of Breast Cancer

Women who are concerned about their risk of developing breast cancer have a new resource at the Breast Center of United Hospital.

The High Risk Breast Clinic offers a comprehensive assessment of breast cancer risk and a plan for ongoing monitoring and management. "We want to help women who should be monitored closely for breast cancer," explained Omer Sanan, MD, of Aspen Medical Group, one of the surgeons who sees patients in the clinic and a specialist in breast cancer surgery.

Patients meet with a registered nurse, surgeon, and genetic counselor. The clinic staff evaluates each patient's medical history and the relevant histories of close family members. An individualized management plan is created, including coordination of breast cancer screenings and options for reducing breast cancer risk.

The goal of screenings is to discover breast cancer at the earliest possible stage, when it's most treatable. Certified genetic counselor Ashley VanDenBoom, MS, works with women who may benefit from genetic testing, recommending the most appropriate strategy for the family.



Some women have found that a clinic visit lessened their anxiety. "They had assumed their own risk of breast cancer as being far higher than we did," Dr. Sanan said. "Some of our patients have been very relieved that their risk, quantified through our models of risk assessment, is actually quite small."

# Charitable Giving – How Long Will Status Quo Last?

In early January, Congress enacted and the President signed the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012. After its passage, one could probably hear a collective sigh of relief from many sectors of the public, including those in the nonprofit sector. We heard constant rhetoric about the need to overhaul our current tax system. We heard about limitation of itemized deductions as a possible solution. We heard about raising taxes on the top 2 percent of taxpayers, defined as having income over \$250,000 as a couple.

When the dust settled, the Bush-era income tax cuts were retained by many people, who did not exceed a much higher threshold. What does this mean for you in regards to charitable giving? In this article, I will try to give you some guidance for 2013 and beyond.

First, rate changes for some, the 3.8 percent additional tax on certain investment income and the Pease limitations on itemized deductions will have a direct effect on whether a current contribution will have maximum tax benefit to the donor. These changes will require one to spend more time with their tax advisors prior to making direct or indirect gifts of cash or property. So, on the one hand, if a person is subject to higher rates, they get more benefit from a charitable deduction. On the other hand, their total deduction may be less valuable because of a greater limitation overall.

Second, having more certainty in the estate tax arena may lead one to look more closely at making charitable transfers by will rather than by current giving. Once again, meeting with your tax advisors, you can address the benefits of current giving over testamentary giving. Be prepared to hear from many charities regarding their wills programs, as there is now greater assurance that tax policy will not constantly change this arena.

Third, while the final effects on this arena could have been quite a bit harsher, on a balance the Act was kind to philanthropy. The fact is that tax laws have, throughout much of our history as a country, generally provided incentives to provide for the benefit of many through a distribution of wealth to organizations that promote a greater quality of life.

In conclusion, you can expect to hear continued calls for your assistance to many organizations throughout 2013 and beyond. You will hear that, as with any tax legislation, it is likely that continued changes will occur or be required, and that you have no better time than the present to act.
