Felhaber Larson:

Law Firm Shares a Long History with United Hospital

The Felhaber Larson Law Firm and United Hospital share a long history in St. Paul. This history underlies the firm's long-standing support for United Hospital Foundation.

Felhaber Larson's roots in St. Paul date to 1928, when attorney Richard Felhaber began practicing law. He developed a specialty in labor law during the Depression and recruited partners Gustav Larson in 1943 and Robert Fenlon and Thomas Vogt in the 1950s.

Today Felhaber Larson has approximately 60 attorneys and 50 other staff members, who work in the firm's St. Paul and Minneapolis offices. Felhaber Larson specializes in labor relations and employment law and is also a full-service law firm serving businesses and individuals throughout the Midwest. The firm's labor and employment practice is particularly strong on behalf of health care organizations, said President Paul Zech.

The firm began representing the hospital industry in the 1960s. "We have been fortunate to represent United before it was in a system, and we have been honored to represent Allina Health for many years," Zech said.

Attorney Mark Mishek is another connection between Felhaber Larson and United. Mishek started his law career with Felhaber Larson. He became general counsel for United in 1981 and later executive vice president of law and public policy at Allina Health. Mishek served as United's president from 2003 to 2008.

Felhaber Larson's charitable support for United Hospital Foundation centers on the United Hospital Golf Classic and the Service to Humanity Gala. Zech and his wife Becky have attended the Gala for years.

"For many years I worked with doctors and health care executives to identify business problems that our firm could propose a product and services solution. I understand what goes on operationally in the hospital." During his tenure with Lawson, one of his clients was United Hospital.



But his path to the United Hospital Foundation board came from a different direction. At a fundraising event, he sat next to longtime United Hospital Foundation board leader Norma Larson. As they talked about Hughes' business expertise and his experience as a board member for other organizations, Larson encouraged him to apply for a board position. Hughes began his United Hospital Foundation board service in January 2004.

"I enjoy giving back to the community in areas where I can have a positive impact," Hughes said. "I come from a family that gives back to the community, whether as philanthropists or as volunteers to support each organization's mission and objectives."

One of Hughes' main activities has been advisory board leadership for the United Hospital Golf Classic. "The Golf Classic committee is a very well-run, collaborative activity among board members, United Hospital Foundation staff and our primary event sponsor," Hughes explained. "I provide board direction and support. I've enjoyed my nine years of current service to support this committee."

In 24 years, the Golf Classic has raised over \$2.5 million for United. The July 2013 tournament attracted 124 golfers and raised over \$150,000 for the Elaine S. Larson Surgical Center at United. Proceeds from each Golf Classic are dedicated to the United Hospital Foundation fundraising priority.

Hughes explained that fundraising is essential to build or enhance facilities at United that provide an excellent experience for patients, along with the safest possible medical care. "Brick-and-mortar projects are not built from the hospital's earnings, but by fundraising itself," he noted.

Now that United's surgery center is completed, United Hospital Foundation's fundraising priority is renovating United's Birth Center. (See page 9.) "This will be our key initiative for the next few years," Hughes said. "The Mother Baby Center at United and Children's-St. Paul is important because when a family has a good birth experience, they will remember that and come back to United Hospital in the future."

Hughes' business acumen served him well during a two year term on the United Hospital Foundation board's executive committee. "The executive committee has total oversight for funding requests to the board," he said. "That requires an assessment of the business case for each request. I enjoyed serving on the committee, because as an operations guy, I could ask articulate questions and help to evaluate funding requests."





10 Years of Saving Lives at MSP Airport

A \$130,000 donation from United Hospital Foundation equipped the Minneapolis – St. Paul International Airport with its first automated external defibrillators (AEDs). The foundation's contribution in 2003 outfitted the huge airport complex with 70 of these lifesaving devices.

Charles Lick, MD, medical director of Allina Health Emergency Medical Services, played a key role in linking United Hospital Foundation with this important public health need at the airport, which serves 33 million passengers a year. AEDs are crucial to saving the lives of people who experience sudden cardiac arrest, a leading cause of death.

The airport was unable to purchase the AEDs, because air travel and revenues dropped after the 2001 terrorist attacks. "United Hospital Foundation stepped up with its donation, and our airport became an early adopter of AEDs among airports in the United States," Dr. Lick said.

Placing AEDs at the airport would have been impossible without funding from United Hospital Foundation, said Fire Chief David Burke of Minneapolis – St. Paul International

Airport. "We continue to be very grateful to the foundation for its wonderful generosity," Burke said. "The airport owes its public access of AEDs to the foundation."

Dr. Lick leads the Allina Health program Heart Safe Communities, a broad effort to combat sudden cardiac arrest. Since 2001, the program has educated 35,000 people in AEDs and cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and placed 2,500 AEDs in the hands of first responders and in public places, businesses and schools.

Sudden cardiac arrest, an electrical malfunction in the heart, is different from a heart attack. Lives are saved when bystanders quickly locate and use AEDs, which give simple audio instructions.

The AED delivers an electric shock called defibrillation, resetting the heart's rhythm. Defibrillation needs to be given within four to five minutes after the person experiences the arrest. "For each additional minute of delay in defibrillation, the patient's success drops 7 to 10 percent," Dr. Lick explained.

AEDs at the airport are used by travelers and employees, Burke said. "It's important that a person receives that first shock before the first responders arrive. Over the years people have come to expect AEDs in public places, just like fire extinguishers."

The Jesse E. Edwards Endowment Fund

The Jesse E. Edwards Registry of Cardiovascular Disease (the Registry) is a consult laboratory examining over 1,500 hearts a year. The Registry has a collection of nearly 28,000 cardiac specimens and over 100,000 photographs. It provides a unique resource for local, national and international physicians which benefits every person interested in heart disease. The endowment fund keeps the Registry here at United.

The Registry was named after Jesse E. Edwards, MD, who made significant contributions to the field of cardiovascular disease. He is widely recognized as the first person to correlate clinical and pathological data in cardiology, and his work on the interplay between the heart and lungs is considered a medical landmark. He founded the Registry at Miller Hospital in the early 1960s.

Today, the Registry is located at United Hospital and led by Medical Director Shannon M. Mackey-Bojack, MD, a forensic and cardiovascular pathologist. Dr. Mackey-Bojack began her medical career interested in pediatric cardiovascular surgery. She soon found that she was more interested in understanding the conditions she was treating, however, and made the change to cardiovascular and forensic

pathology. The scope of this work is broad and deep, and frequently includes conditions some doctors may never see.

Dr. Mackey-Bojack said, "We continue to provide research into all aspects of cardiovascular disease, including sudden death, genetics and more. As a consultant lab, we receive referred hearts and tissues from around the country. Additionally, each year we receive 200-250 referrals from medical examiners and hospital pathologists when a cause of death or diagnosis is complicated." Once the specimen is received, more tests are run to help determine the cause of death. All specimens are kept onsite. In fact, the Registry has hearts dating back to 1947.

The importance of the Registry

In 2005, Dr. Mackey-Bojack was contacted by a mother whose son died suddenly at an early age. When no cause of death was identified, this mother turned to other sources for an answer. She was worried about her other two children and wanted to make sure the cause was not genetic. And if it was, she wanted to know that, too, to help inform care plans.

She did some research, found the Registry and contacted Dr. Mackey-Bojack whose examination found the heart displayed findings not previously described. Over the next 18 months, she identified similar cases also recently referred to the Registry and determined the cause to be a cardiomyopathy, a potentially inheritable condition of the heart muscle. She was able to share that information with a very concerned mother who, in turn, shared it with her children.

You can help save lives

"Nobody likes to talk about death. While we wish we didn't have to do what we do, we know we are helping to prevent death," said Dr. Mackey-Bojack. "By accumulating data and trends, we can help prevent death, prolong life or offer treatment options."

Boxes Full of Memories



Families at United Hospital help other parents deal with the unimaginable: losing a baby



United Hospital's Birth Center resounds with happiness as families welcome their new babies. Relatives and friends come to cradle the infants and congratulate the new parents. Sisters and brothers are excited to see their new family member.

Yet, amid the joy are families who are experiencing a loss they never imagined: a baby's stillbirth or an infant's death. The Birth Center has a strong tradition of helping these families, thanks to parents who have walked the difficult road of loss and grief themselves.

These parents understand something that few people would: It's important to create physical mementos in the short time parents spend with their babies at the Birth Center. To do that, several families have volunteered to provide special

memory boxes. Packed inside are items to help parents create keepsakes to remember their baby: a memory box for hair clippings and the hospital bracelet; a small plaster mold to preserve tiny handprints and footprints; a washcloth and special soaps to bathe the baby; a handmade blanket; a bracelet for the mother; and other meaningful items.

Wittmans Create the Olivia Fund

This circle of caring begins with parents Dave and Cheryl Wittman. In 1998 their daughter Olivia Catherine was born without a heartbeat at the Birth Center. In her memory, the Wittmans established the Olivia Fund at United Hospital Foundation to help other parents who experienced loss. For five years the Wittmans organized a golf tournament that raised money for the fund.

The idea for the boxes originated with parents Amy Kuebelbeck and Mark Neuzil. They suffered the loss of their infant son Gabriel in 1999. Although they were able to bring items to the hospital to create keepsakes of Gabriel's birth, they realized other parents wouldn't have that opportunity. Using memorial funds dedicated to Gabriel, Amy created boxes of things she had carefully chosen.

Then, volunteers from United's Pregnancy and Infant Loss Support Group continued the tradition. For years, the Olivia Fund has helped to underwrite the cost of the memory boxes.

"This project has turned into a true vehicle of healing for others, beyond our own personal circle," Dave and Cheryl said. "It is very gratifying for us to see the impact not only on parents who receive memory boxes, but also on those who take the time and care to create them."



'The Items Inside Were So Precious'

Now, parent Melody Johnson leads the boxes project, turning her grief into something positive. Melody and Erik Johnson were expecting their third child in 2012. In the 33rd week of pregnancy, Melody felt her baby have a series of seizures. Her doctor told the couple that baby Solveig Sofia had died in the womb; after her birth they learned the cause was an umbilical cord accident.

The Johnsons chose the Birth Center at United for Solveig's delivery. They were surprised to receive a memory box from their nurse. She encouraged them to look through it before Melody's labor was induced and think about how they could use the items in the few hours they'd spend with Solveig.

"Immediately upon opening the box, the tears began to pour from our eyes," Melody recalled. "Knowing that we qualified to receive this box was humbling, and yet another reality of our situation. The real gift was that the items inside were so precious, and were indeed helpful in preparing us to have our baby. They were also helpful for our children, helping us have tangible memories of our daughter and their sister."

Several weeks later, Melody kept thinking about how much the box meant to her family. She talked with Annette Klein, RN, who works with bereaved families at the Birth Center. Klein explained that the boxes are provided as gifts from other families who had experienced losses. Klein said she needed a new coordinator for the box project and gently asked whether Melody was interested.

After several weeks of thinking and praying, Melody said yes. The boxes she assembles are called Solvieg's Boxes. Each contains a letter to parents, which explains the importance of making physical momentos. "We hope that you can find comfort in the memories that your child has left behind for you. We pray that these items can ease your burden even a little bit," the letter states.

For Melody and Erik, helping other families has been vital to their own healing process. "We've been able to take our sadness and grief and turn some of it around into a positive project to help others in the community," Melody said. "It is really a humbling honor to be part of their journey."



How You Can Support the Olivia Fund

Donations to the Olivia Fund at United Hospital Foundation are essential to supporting families who experience loss at the Birth Center.

Items in the memory boxes are carefully chosen to help parents comfort their babies and create momentos. Among the items: a handmade blanket and flannel warmer; baby bath soap and washcloth; a handprint/ footprint memory kit; a memory box for hair clippings and hospital bracelet; a small teddy bear; a CD of lullabies; two books to help parents with their grief; a beaded bracelet for the mother with a footprint charm.

Melody Johnson, the parent who coordinates the memory boxes, convinced craftspeople, artists and store managers to make donations or give generous discounts. Still, each box costs about \$66.

She explained how donors can make a difference by contributing to the Olivia Fund: "Please remember the families who will be receiving the boxes. They will be facing unimaginable grief and sorrow. It is our heart's desire that the items in the boxes can help to ease their sorrow, even just a small bit. The boxes will help them to create lasting memories with the child that they are saying goodbye to all too soon."

Volunteers are the backbone of United Hospital

Just as the world of health care is changing, so is the world of hospital volunteers. "Our volunteers come from all walks of life. A lot of volunteers are newly retired, active and willing to be on their feet for long periods of time. And we have a lot of younger, middle and high school age volunteers. We even had one volunteer feel so strongly about nursing that she established her own fund, The Julie Cohen United Hospital Volunteer and Nursing Education Fund, specifically designed for those volunteers who are also pursuing nursing degrees," said Pat Hanzal, Volunteer and Guest Services manager.

The changing demographics create an exciting volunteer program to serve United Hospital's guest and patient needs. When Pat Hanzal took over the volunteer department in 2006, the average age of a volunteer was 76. In 2013, the average age was 30. Today's volunteers are younger, they volunteer as part of their life before retirement and many are students from local colleges and high schools. They also bring an influx of greater diversity of cultures, talents and interest. The volunteer program matches the diversity in today's changing hospital operations. The program has over 690 volunteers who contribute their time and talents on a regular basis. And more volunteers are needed.

Training

Volunteers are required to complete appropriate training before they are assigned volunteer tasks in the hospital. These include medical checks, patient privacy concerns and training on the hospital philosophy of service to others. A computerized system of scheduling makes it easier to manage such a large and diverse number of volunteers. Volunteers complement and work under the direction of staff.

Camp United

"A lot of junior volunteers were being recruited and trained but they would only volunteer once or twice," said Pat. Her team started something special to help keep younger volunteers engaged: Camp United.

Camp United is United Hospital's summer volunteer program for middle and high school students age 14-17. Six, two-week camp sessions are offered throughout the summer. Camp United is the perfect solution for busy students who want to impact the community by volunteering.

"Campers" help patients, families and staff by performing various duties in Guest Services, Patient Discharge Service, Gift Shop, Patient Services and more. Some camp volunteers return every year and can become a "camp counselor," leading newer camp volunteers.

How You Can Help

"We are always looking for more daytime volunteers," Pat Hanzal said. "Consider becoming a volunteer or refer your friends and family. United recognizes the contribution volunteers play in making it the right kind of place for patients and their families to feel comfortable when receiving care."

And if supporting our mission to provide excellent care, as we prevent illness, restore health and provide comfort to all who entrust us with their care isn't enough, volunteers frequently say, "I get a lot of exercise. I don't need a club membership, I just volunteer."

United Hospital Foundation is beginning a fundraising campaign to upgrade the Birth Center into The Mother Baby Center at United and Children's-St. Paul.

Focused on seamless care from routine deliveries to complex, high-risk births, The Mother Baby Center at United and Children's-St. Paul will continue to be the east metro's only tertiary care center for infants born before 32 weeks gestation. The 62-bed newborn intensive care unit (NICU) is one of the largest, most sophisticated Level III nurseries in Minnesota. The NICU cares for a large share of the state's highest risk babies and has some of the best outcomes in the world.

The Mother Baby Center at United and Children's-St. Paul will include a total of 30,000 square feet of new space and remodeled existing units to offer larger, more comfortable rooms.

Additional features include:

- 7 triage rooms
- 11 new large labor and delivery rooms. Approximately 375 square feet, each room provides resuscitation areas, generous clear space for medical teams, baby warmers and equipment.
- 2 rooms with tubs for mothers who choose to labor in water.
- 30 postpartum rooms with larger spaces for family, friends and care givers. Each will be approximately 220 square feet.

- 14 rooms for mothers on bedrest, that can also serve as postpartum rooms
- 3 new operating rooms
- 3 post-anesthesia recovery rooms
- Each room will have a rolling cabinet for the family's clothing and belongs, and will move with the family after birth, eliminating the need to repack
- Expanded facilities for staff

United Hospital Foundation is raising funds to help cover the expected cost of building/renovation, equipment and furnishings. The Mother Baby Center at United and Children's-St. Paul will be the vital resource the community deserves. Families will be able to say without reservation, "There is no place but United to have a baby."

19 percent of adults in Minnesota are not physically active at all. Walking for as few as 30 minutes a day improves heart health.

78 percent of adults in Minnesota consume fewer than five fruits and vegetable servings per day.

Smoking doubles to triples the risk of heart disease. One year after quitting smoking, a person's risk of coronary heart disease is reduced by 50 percent.

Preventive Cardiologist: This 40-minute consultation includes a thorough cardiovascular history and physical as well as risk factor, lifestyle, and behavior assessments.

Registered Dietician: This 60-minute in-depth visit focuses on existing eating patterns and opportunities to improve overall nutrition.

Elaine S. Larson Surgical Center Opens



Thanks to the generosity of our donors, the Elaine S. Larson Surgical Center officially opened on Friday, Jan. 24. Prior to the renovation,

United Hospital's operating rooms averaged between 315 and 469 square feet, too small to meet the current standards of 600 square feet including minimally invasive procedures.

The entire scope of project:






Total Contributions



Total Income





Grants and Allocations

Do I just want to provide for the betterment of others after I have exhausted any current needs for my wealth?

The point is that each one of us is different and we may view that our legacy is not just to our own families but may also be to the community as a whole. The decisions one makes are to be taken after discussing them with others that may include only one's family or with exclusion of one's family. It is a choice for each of us, and it usually requires meeting with our own financial advisors as to how to best achieve the charitable goals we set. There are a number of vehicles out there that can make one a philanthropist while replacing overall family wealth.
