Test	You need if you:	Date done	Comments
<input type="checkbox"/> Pap smear and pelvic exam: every year	are a woman		
<input type="checkbox"/> mammogram: every year	are a woman older than age 40		
<input type="checkbox"/> PSA (prostate specific antigen): every year	are a man age 50 or older		
<input type="checkbox"/> heart stress test: may need every year	are age 45 or older, have diabetes or have heart disease or symptoms		
<input type="checkbox"/> colonoscopy: every five years	age 50 or older, if you have not had one within the last five years, or if you have family history of colon cancer		
<input type="checkbox"/> pulmonary function tests, lung breathing tests	have a history of lung problems or if you are a heavy smoker (one or more packs a day)
