Patients are seen at Abbott Northwestern Hospital in Minneapolis and United Hospital in St. Paul, Minn.

CONDITIONS TREATED

- autoimmune disorders
- · complex cardiac disease
- · complex cardiac disorders
- complex Gl/Hepatobiliary compromise
- complex thromboembolic history with need for therapeutic anticoagulation
- complicated IDDM
- hematologic disorders
- increased BMI (≥ 50)
- morbidly adherent placenta
- nephrology: ESRD; current dialysis; transplant
- neurology: complex epilepsy; Para/ quadriplegic syndromes
- oncology
- chronic health issues including: hypertension and pulmonary conditions
- rheumatology

All core team members ensure a consistent, comprehensive care plan. The role of the primary provider is a key member of the team and participates in the care of their patient.
