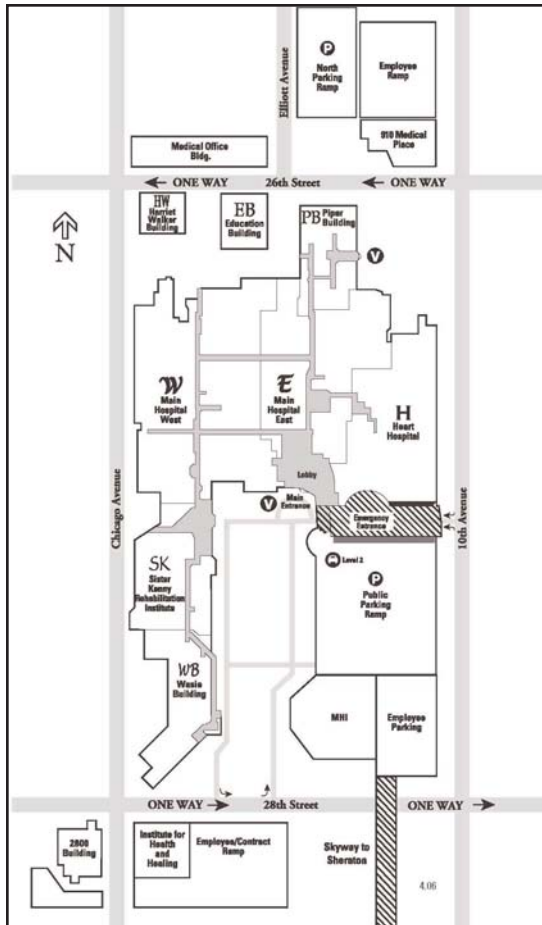


Parking On City Streets

Parking Safety

- ◆ Park in well-lit ramps and lots.
- ◆ Be alert to your surroundings — look around before getting out of your car.
- ◆ Know exactly where you parked and your safest exit route.
- ◆ Always lock your car doors.
- ◆ Always keep door and ignition keys handy.
- ◆ Leave only ignition key with lot attendant.
- ◆ Return to car using the buddy system, a group or with a personal escort (call Public Safety at 612-863-5416 to arrange for an escort).
- ◆ Look inside before entering your car.
- ◆ If someone tries to enter your vehicle, honk horn repeatedly and try to drive away.

Parking Enforcement

Enforcement applies to all vehicles parked on lots, in ramps or drives on the Abbott Northwestern Hospital campus, and the parking ramps shared with Children's Hospital and Clinics-Minneapolis.

Enforcement encourages full utilization of limited parking capacities, maintains access and traffic flow, and ensures fire lanes are open.

The Public Safety Department defines and enforces parking violations and collects fees for violations. Public Safety reserves the right to tow any vehicle that is unsafely or inappropriately positioned in accordance with Abbott Northwestern's towing policy.

Tow Policy

Any unattended vehicle will be towed if it is obstructing a vehicle entrance to the hospital; obstructing the vehicle traffic flow in the Founders' Mall, loading dock or parking ramp; or has an immediate impact on the immediate safety of the hospital.

Employees who continue to violate parking policies, or fail to respond to a parking citation either by making payment or filing an appeal, could have their vehicle towed and/or have parking privileges on hospital-owned/controlled property revoked.

Citation Types/Fines

1st / 2nd / 3rd / 4th Violations

- 1. No handicapped plates/permit**
Warning / \$50 / \$100 / \$200
- 2. Parking for more than 4 hours in 4-hour special H/C stall**
Warning / \$25 / \$55 / \$105
- 3. Parking in Fire Lane**
Warning / \$25 / \$55 + Tow Policy / \$105 + Tow Policy
- 4. Parking in Tow-Away Zone**
Warning / \$25 / \$55 + Tow Policy / \$105 + Tow Policy
- 5. Using other Specialty Parking against policy (Valet, Courier, Radon, Delivery)**
Warning / \$25 / \$55 / \$105
- 6. Employee failure to display sticker**
Warning / \$25 / \$55 / \$105
- 7. Employee parking in visitor space**
Warning / \$25 / \$55 / \$105
- 8. Abandoned/stored vehicle**
Warning / Tow / Tow / Tow
- 9. General violations**
Warning / \$25 / \$55 / \$105
- 10. Employee loses or forgets parking card at ramp/lot exit**

What You Need To Do If You Receive A Citation

1. You must respond to the citation within 14 days from the date it is issued.
2. Leave your payment with a valet attendant, or send your payment to:

3. You have the right to appeal. All appeals must be submitted in writing within 14 days of the issuance of the citation. You may download the form at www.abbottnorthwestern.com/ahs/anw.nsf/page/parking or you may call 612-863-9735 and leave your name, address and citation number, and the form will be sent to you. You will be notified of your appeal date.
4. Appeals may result in penalties being upheld, dismissed or moderated. The decision of the appeal will be final.
