- Inpatient and outpatient therapy services, including physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech language pathology, stroke rehabilitation, brain injury services, cognitive performance testing, Parkinson's LSVT training, and cancer rehabilitation and lymphedema program.

Emergency Services

- 24-hour emergency services.
- Intensive Care Unit
- Board-certified emergency physicians.
- Designated as Level IV Trauma Center by the state of Minnesota.
- All-private rooms with specialty rooms for sexual assault, mental health and critical care.
- Community outreach services, including injury, domestic violence and abuse prevention and safety presentations.

Heart and Vascular Services

- Diagnostic services, including cardiac computed tomography (CT) with calcium scoring, cardiac stress testing, nuclear stress testing, Holter monitoring, echocardiography, transesophageal echocardiograms (TEE), elective cardioversion and vascular angiograms.
- Interventional services, including vascular stents, aortic stents, pacemakers, ICDs and ablations and elective cardioversion.
- Comprehensive cardiac rehabilitation.
- Stroke, cardiac, vascular (legs) and respiratory preventive screenings.
- Respiratory services, including pulmonary testing, rehabilitation, and pulmonary support groups.
